## Volunteer Opportunities

- **Workers** to operate The Closet- Must be available at least once per month on Thursdays from 10:00a.m.-12:30p.m. or 12:30-3:00p.m.
- **Clothing Sorters/Organizers**-Help sort and organize clothes by size and season to match together outfits. Typically Tuesday's!
- **Laundry Helpers**-To wash, dry, and fold clothing donations that come in. (Laundry is done at your home or fcs)
- **Donations**-Sort and count donations in donation bins. Carefully looking for stains and holes in clothing. Disinfecting toys and shoes. Typically Tuesday's!

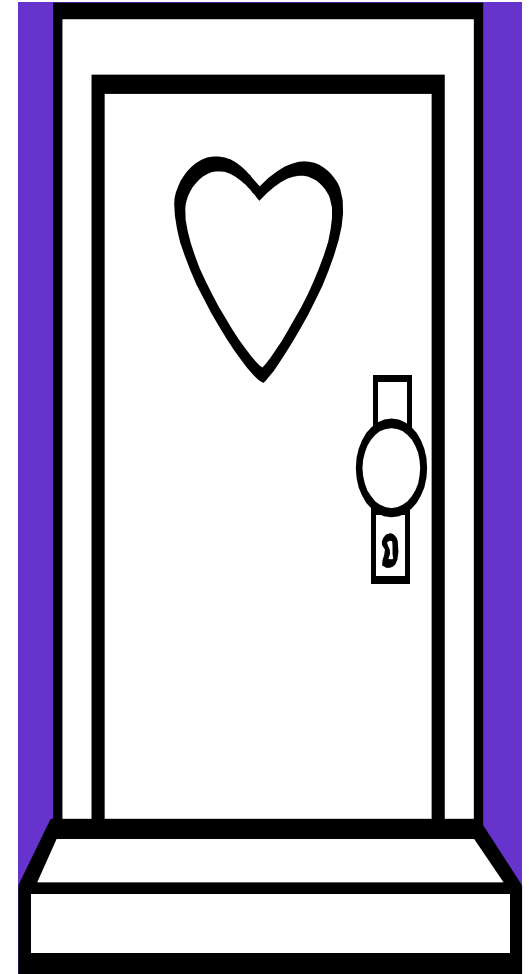

The Closet simply by presenting a utility bill or other piece of mail with their name and address. Some clients come to us through referrals from other Family Centered Services programs and others find out about our program through brochures left at strategic places throughout the community.

Each family may shop once per month for infants-children under 6years old.

## Items Available

### Diapers & Wipes

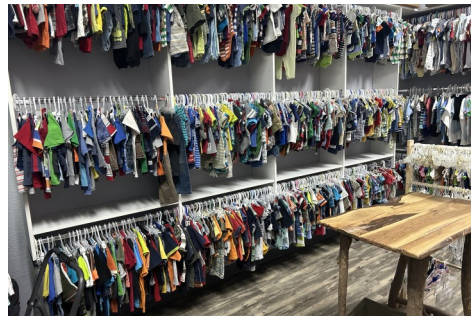
Clients receive one bundle of diapers for each child per month and a pack of wipes.

- Diapers are re-packaged into bundle sets to make them go further; our volunteers work on bundling on Tuesday's.

### Toiletries

Families receive three toiletry items per month. Items we offer include:
